Beet	Golden	(55 days)			Heirloom. Golden's orange roots don't bleed when cooked but turn a deep golden yellow. Its oval-shaped roots grow fast, yet retain sweet flavor even when quite large. Golden beets are tender and mild; an excellent choice for pickling.		4-pk
Bok Choi	Tatsoi				21 days baby; 45 days full size. Smooth leaves for salad mixes. Leaves form a compact, thick rosette. Long harvest period. Mild flavor for salads, stir-fries, etc. Thin to 6-8" apart for full-sized rosettes. Unique and easy to grow. Suitable for late spring through autumn sowing.		4-pk
Borage	Starflower	(50-60 days)			Annual. Drought tolerant. Edible flowers and leaves with mild cucumber flavor. Large plants bear hundreds of small star-like flowers, mostly blue and some pink. Stays attractive and green long into the fall and readily self-sows for the next season. A favorite of the bees! (<i>Borage officinalis</i>)		4-pk
Broccoli	Di Ciccio	(48 days)			Hardy annual. Heirloom. Vigorous, light-green plant of 1890 Italian origin. Produce a 3"-4" bluish-green central head with many medium-sized side shoot for a prolonged harvest. Great tasting and good choice for spring or fall planting.		3.50
Cilantro (Coriander)					Goes to seed when it gets hot. Harvest leaves throughout the season. Dry seeds and stems in a warm, airy place. Will reseed. A staple in Mexican, Indian, and Asian cuisines. <i>Coriandrum sativum</i> .		4-pk
Cucumber	Crystal Apple	(65 days)			Heirloom originally from New Zealand. Apple shaped when mature. Very tender, creamy white skin. Mild flavor; great for fresh eating; very prolific. Best used when small.		3.50
Cucumber	Lemon	(65 days)			Unusual cuke is bright lemon yellow, round, and best when harvested at 2" across for either pickles or salads. Flavor is sweet, mild, never bitter, with an old-fashioned cucumber flavor with a hint of nuttiness. Heirloom		3.50
Cucumber	Marketmore 76	(65 days)			Reliably produces heavy yields of straight, dark green, white-spined, 9 in. fruits with a mild sweet flavor. Good for slicing. Superb disease resistance.		3.50

Uniform fruit reach a generous 8-1/2 to 9" long and have glossy dark green skin with scanty, white spines. High yielding plants are heat tolerant and disease resistant. Eggplant	Amadeo Hybrid	(65 days)			Rich, nutty succulence and total lack of bitterness. Spineless 3-ft plant is very heavy-bearing, delivering masses of 5" by 8" dark purple to black oval fruit. Easy to pick and irresistible on the tongue. The plant will probably need support when it starts bearing.		3.50
Eggplant	Black Beauty	(74-80 days)	OP		Popular heirloom variety. Glossy fruits become quite large, but are well shaped and perfect for thick slices for grilling.		3.50
Eggplant	Nadia Hybrid	(70 days)			Glossy dark purple-black skin and outstanding fruit and production qualities make this variety special. Its classic Italian shape is an elongated oval to 9" long and fruit has a very firm flesh with a slow seed development. Sets well even under cool conditions.		3.50
Eggplant	Orient Charm Hybrid	(65 days)			Attractive, slender, 8-10" fruits in the Oriental style with alluring shades of fluorescent pink, pastel pink, and white with green calyx. Strong plant with high yields.		3.50

Herb	Cutting Celery	(80-85 days)			Annual. Leafy herb with bold celery flavor. Use fresh in salads or cooked in soups, stews, and with mixed vegetables. Also known as leaf celery.		4-pk

Herb	Fennel, Bronze	(50-60 days)			Feathery bronze-red colored foliage with sweet flavor. Nonbulbing type. Leaves nice addition fo salads, cole slaw, and dressings. Very ornamental. Perennial.		4-pk
Herb	Garlic Chives, Chinese Chives				Attractive perennial closely related to common Chives but with a mild garlic flavor. Very ornamental plant and white flowers. The wide leaves are flat, solid, and dark green. The plant grows into a clump. Height 15-18". <i>Allium tuberosum</i> .		4-pk
Herb	Greek Oregano				Perennial. Heavy oregano aroma. Characteristic dark green leaves with white flowers. <i>Origanum vulgare hirtum</i> .		4-pk
Herb	Lemon Grass				Tropical perennial grass. All plant parts are strongly lemon scented and are widely used as ingredients in Southeast Asian cooking.		4-pk
Herb	Lovage				Perennial. Specialty culinary herb. Young leaves taste like celery and are used in spring tonic salads and with potato, rice, and poultry dishes. Height 48-78". <i>Levisticum officinale</i> .		4-pk
Herb	Marjoram Sweet				Purple spikes of sweet flowers on plants 2 feet tall and 1-1/2 feet wide. Leaves are perfect for flavoring meats and vegetables. Annual.		4-pk

Lettuce	Little Gem	(68 days)			Miniature Romaine type has the succulent sweetness of a butterhead. Glossy-leaved heads are a petite 6" tall and 4" wide. Has a tender blanched heart. Plant 6" apart. Harvest individual leaves or cut whole plant to 2" above ground level when it is up to 6" tall; more leaves will be produced.		4-pk
Lettuce	Muir	(50 days)			A very heat tolerant full size head lettuce. The light green, extra wavy leaves form dense heads at a small size and can be harvested as mini or full-size heads.		4-pk
Lettuce	Parris Island Romaine	(29 days)			The standard green romaine for baby leaf. Provides good flavor and texture to salad mix. Dark green leaves.		4-pk
Lettuce	Red Cross	(48 days)			Heat tolerant red butterhead. The large, fancy, bright red heads make a stunning presentation. Suitable for spring, summer, and fall crops. Downy mildew resistant.		4-pk
Lettuce	Skyphos	(47 days)			Most adaptable butterhead. Beautiful, large dark red heads with nicely contrasting green centers. Excellent flavor and texture. The surest heading of red butterheads. Resistant to downy mildew.		4-pk
Lettuce	Sparx	(58 days)			Heat-tolerant romaine for hearts. High-yielding, upright, dense heads produce long, uniform hearts with good flavor. Ideal for spring, summer, or fall harvests. Resistant to downy mildew.		4-pk

It was selected to have a milder, freher flavor than most chilis, with thick, meaty walls, and large peppers up to 8" long. Good roasted, fresh, dried and canned. Pepper	Ancho (Poblano)	(65-80 days)		Medium hot	When fresh and still green, these mildly hot heart-shaped peppers are stuffed and made into chiles rellenos. Pepper	Ancho Magnifico Hybrid	(75 days)	HY	Medium hot	Very large, thick-walled anchos turn from green to bright red, and possess a classic poblano flavor. Pepper	Barker's Hot	(75-85 days)	HL	Hot	Large Anaheim type 5" to 7" long and 1" to 2" wide. Thin skin makes it good for roasting, frying whole, or stuffing. Fruits ripen from green to bright red; heat increases as peppers become redder. Selected from a native New Mexican chile.		3.50
Pepper	Carmen Hybrid	(60-70 days)		Sweet Non-bell	Horn-shaped Italian pepper, with a delightful flavor that's noticeable sweeter than other varieties, raw or cooked. Firm, tapered fruits grow to about 5 oz., 6" long and 2-1/2" wide, maturing green to red on upright, leafy plants. Excellent yields, widely adaptable, reliable and easy-to-grow.		3.50
Pepper	Cascabel	(90 days)		Hot	Very pungent globe-shaped peppers, about the size and shape of a hot cherry pepper. It is most popular in its dried form, when the skin turns dark reddish-brown and the seeds are so loose they rattle. Cascabel is Spanish for sleigh bell or jingle bell.		3.50
Pepper	Cayenne Long Thin	(75-90 days)		Very hot	Dependable producer. Bushy 26" tall plants produce 4-6" long fruit. Colorful when used as a dried pepper. They also freeze well. Fruits are dark green turning bright red at maturity. Pungency develops early so fruit can be used from 1" and up.		3.50
Pepper	Chile de Arbol			Hot	Anaheim type pepper 3" x 3/8", green, thin wall, dries red. Spicy flavor for sauces and soups.		3.50
Pepper	Corno di Toro Rosso			Sweet	Long 8" tapered, bull-horn shaped, red peppers are sweet and spicy. Great fresh or roasted. Pure Italian seed.		3.50

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Pepper	Fresno	(75 days)		Medium hot	If you grow only one hot pepper this year, consider making it Fresno. This mildly hot pepper is a very heavy producer, with consistently glossy, high-quality, 2" by 1" fruit, on 24-30" plants. It needs little water during the growth season compared with many others, and you can tailor its heat level by picking it green for mildest flavor, deep red for hottest, and orange for a happy medium. Not suitable for drying into spice but ideal for eating fresh, stuffing, canning, pickling, frying, sauteing, and more.		3.50
Pepper	Garden Salsa Hybrid	(73 days)		Medium hot	Perfect for making into homemade salsa. The heat level is in the medium range, about the same as Jalapeno. Also useful for picante sauce and various other Mexican dishes. Smooth green peppers are 8" to 9" long and 1" wide, ripening to red.		3.50
Pepper	Golden Cal Wonder	(68 days)		Sweet Bell	Very sweet, blocky-shaped, 4-lobed bell pepper with thick flesh and almost 4" in diameter. Fruits ripen from medium green to golden yellow to deep orange. Sturdy, upright plants are everbearing.		3.50
Pepper	Golden Treasure	(80 days)		Sweet Non-bell	Italian heirloom variety, excellent for frying, roasting and fresh eating. Long, 9" fruits ripen from green to shiny yellow. Sweet flavor with medium thick flesh and tender skin.		3.50

Pepper	Italico Spicy Hybrid	(65 days)		Mildly spicy	European import that resembles a green chili but delivers a flavorful, spicy taste rather than heat. Early, thin-walled, 7 in. fruits cook quickly, making them perfect when grilled or fried. Vigorous, productive plants. (Formerly called Spanish Spice.)		3.50
Pepper	Jalapeno	(75 days)		Hot	Enjoyed raw, pickled, canned and cooked, these versatile, 2" long peppers are easy to grow and prolific. Peppers are green until fully ripe, when they turn red. Harvest by cutting--not pulling--when peppers reach the desired size & color		3.50
Pepper	Jimmy Nardello	(80 days)		Sweet	One of the sweetest non-bell peppers you'll ever taste. Bright red, 6" to 8" long peppers are about 1" wide and somewhat wrinkled in appearance. Great for frying or salads. Expect large yields.		3.50
Pepper	Mama Mia Giallo Hybrid	(80 days)		Sweet Non-bell	An elongated Bull's Horn type awarded 2014 AAS honors due to its huge yields, uniform shape, smooth skin and beautiful yellow-gold color when mature. Fruits are 7 to 9 in. long and weigh 5 oz., with a sweet flavor that's perfect fresh, roasted, or grilled. Compact 24" plants tolerant to TMV.		3.50
Pepper	Marconi Red	(70-90 days)		Sweet Non-bell	Deep red, extremely sweet, 7" long Italian peppers are tapered with a blunt end. Often used for frying but are also delicious when eaten fresh. Vigorous plants bear loads of high quality fruit.		3.50
Pepper	Mirasol	(68 days)		Medium Hot	Known as Guajillo in their dried form, which are one of the main chiles used in mole sauces. Conical in shape and commonly 4"-5" long and 2" wide. It is red to dark red, or copper in color. The peppers grow facing upwards		3.50
Pepper	NuMex Bailey Piquin	(120 days)	OP	Very Hot	Also know as the bird pepper or chilepiquin. Unique because the fruit falls from the stem at maturity, making harvesting easier. Oblong small fruit sets high in the plant canopy and when dried, has a pungency of 97,000 Scoville units.		3.50
Pepper	NuMex Joe E. Parker	(65 days)		Medium hot	Thick fleshed peppers are 6" to 7" long and turn from green to red. They are relatively mild to medium in flavor, and ripen earlier than most other peppers of their type.		3.50
Pepper	NuMex Sandia	(75-80 days)		Medium hot	This NuMex type pepper is smaller and hotter than Big Jim and Joe E. Parker, delivering pungent 4 to 6 inch Anaheim type peppers. They turn bright scarlet when ripe but are often used while green. The red ones can be dried to make decorative ristras.		3.50
Pepper	NuMex Sunrise	(75 days)		Mild	4"-6" long by 1-1/2" wide fruits on 28" tall plants. Medium green, thick walled fruits turn bright yellow at maturity. Was developed for ornamental purposes and is excellent for drying and making into wreaths or ristras.		3.50
Pepper	NuMex Sunset	(69-80 days)		Mild	4"-6" long by 1-1/2" wide fruits on 24" tall plants. Medium green, thick walled fruits turn orange at maturity. Was developed for ornamental purposes and is excellent for drying and making into wreaths or ristras.		3.50
Pepper	NuMex Twilight	(120 days)		Very hot	An ornamental piquin-type chile with green leaves and purple fruit that ripens to yellow, orange, and then red. This variety has fruit in all four color states at the same time. Very striking and great for containers.		3.50
Pepper	Padron	(50-65 days)		Mild to Hot	Spanish heirloom and tapa bar favorite. Traditionally used in its immature green stage, when it is picked quite small (thumb/olive size), sauteed in olive oil, and served in a bowl with stems on. Peppers are mild when small and green, but get hotter as they grow. At full maturity, they are about 2-1/2" long and 1-1/4" wide, deep red and fiery hot. Vigorous, prolific plants.		3.50
